## ***A note from Rev. Harry...***

It has come to vestry's attention that there are a number of maintenance tasks within the church grounds. Some examples of these include the repair of the flashings near the church narthex, addressing the drainage issues on the southern side of the church, and replacing light bulbs above the sanctuary.

In response vestry has engaged the Greytown Handy Man to be on site twice a month to address some of the basic maintenance tasks here on our main church site. Quotes are also being sought regarding the drainage of the carpark and sealed access to the church entrance from the road. Also, a Treecologist

and an arborist have recently been on site assessing the state of our historic trees.

Many thanks to all those on vestry who have been involved in this recent flurry of activity. Particularly, I would like to thank Julian Downs and Amy Williams for their assistance in engaging the Handy Man and proactively caring for the trees along our fence line. Thanks also to Paley Downs for being on-site to direct the work as required.

I believe we have a duty to act as good stewards of the resources God has made available to us, and these actions show that we are taking this duty seriously.
